Types of Data collected

Among the Personal Data collected by this Website, independently or through third parties, there are: Tracking Tool; Data of use; answers to questions; click; keypress events; events related to motion sensors; mouse movements; position relative to the slide; touch events; email; name; surname; telephone number; VAT number; company name; physical address; province; CAP; various types of Data; city; Fiscal Code.

Full details on each type of data collected are provided in the dedicated sections of this privacy policy or through specific informative texts displayed before the collection of the data. Personal Data may be freely provided by the User or, in the case of Usage Data, collected automatically during the use of this Website.

Unless otherwise specified, all Data required by this Website is mandatory. If you refuse to provide them, it may be impossible for this Website to provide the Service. In cases where this Website indicates certain Data as optional, Users are free to refrain from communicating such Data, without this having any consequences on the availability of the Service or its operation. Users who have doubts about which Data is mandatory, are encouraged to contact the Owner. Method and place of processing of the collected Data

Method of treatment

The Data Controller shall take appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, modification or destruction of Personal Data.

The processing is carried out by means of computer and/ or telematic tools, with organizational methods and logic strictly related to the purposes indicated. In addition to the Data Controller, in some cases, other parties involved in the organization of this Website (administrative, commercial, marketing, legal, system administrators) or external subjects may have access to the Data (as third-party technical service providers, postal couriers, hosting providers, IT companies, communication agencies) also appointed, if necessary, Data Processors by the Data Controller. Legal basis of processing

The Data Controller processes Personal Data relating to the User if one of the following conditions is met:

- the User has given consent for one or more specific purposes; Note: in some jurisdictions the Data Controller may be authorised to process Personal Data without the User's consent or another of the legal bases specified below, until the User objects ("opt-out") to such processing. However, this does not apply if the processing of Personal Data is regulated by European legislation on the protection of Personal Data;
- the processing is necessary for the execution of a contract with the User and/or for the execution of pre-contractual measures;
- the processing is necessary to fulfil a legal obligation to which the Data Controller is subject;
- the processing is necessary for the performance of a task in the public interest or for the exercise of public authority by the Data Controller;
- the processing is necessary for the pursuit of the legitimate interest of the Data Controller or third parties.

It is however always possible to ask the Data Controller to clarify the concrete legal basis of each processing and in particular to specify whether the processing is based on the law, provided by a contract or necessary to conclude a contract.

Place

The Data are processed at the operating offices of the Data Controller and at any other place where the parties involved in the processing are located. For further information, contact the Data Controller.

Retention period

The Data are processed and stored for the time required by the purposes for which they were collected.

Therefore:

- The Personal Data collected for purposes related to the legitimate interest of the Data Controller will be retained until the satisfaction of this interest. The User can obtain further information about the legitimate interest pursued by the Data Controller in the relevant sections of this document or by contacting the Data Controller.

When processing is based on the User's consent, the Data Controller may retain the Personal Data for longer until such consent is revoked. In addition, the Data Controller may be obliged to store Personal Data for a longer period in compliance with a legal obligation or by order of an authority.

At the end of the retention period, Personal Data will be deleted. Therefore, upon expiry of this period, the right of access, cancellation, rectification and the right to data portability can no longer be exercised.
